### Leavers' Assembly

To celebrate the end of their time at Ladywell Primary School our P7 children will have their Leavers' Assembly on Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> June at 10am. This year this assembly will be held in the school as opposed to the church. This decision was taken after concerns were raised about our ever increasing roll and the fact that there was limited space within the church to accommodate all children and parents safely.

Siblings of the P7 children currently within the school will be invited to attend this assembly along with parents/carers.

To ensure everyone is involved in celebrating with the P7s the whole school will attend the final rehearsal of the assembly on Wednesday afternoon.

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### Modular Unit

As our roll continues to increase, next session we will have 14 classes. To accommodate all of our children a modular unit will be installed. I am hoping that this work will be done throughout the summer holidays, ready for the new term beginning.

The brand new modular unit will consist of two carpeted classes, fully fitted with air conditioning and smart boards, with toilet and cloakroom facilities.

It is my intention that our most senior pupils, our P7s will be based here.

### Breakfast Provision

As of August 2018 all Primary Schools in North Lanarkshire will offer a Breakfast Service. Our Breakfast Service will begin on Monday 20<sup>th</sup> August and is open to all pupils from 8.15am. All children, including P1-P3 pupils, pay for breakfast unless in receipt of Free School Meal entitlement. The cost of breakfast is £1 per child. However, if more than one sibling from the same family attends for breakfast the cost for the second child is 50p and for the third child 30p. All children from the same family must attend at the same time and pay for all meals on the eldest child's payment card. Breakfast consists of 4 items from a choice of cereal, white or brown toast, fruit juice and milk.

Children can swap any of the 4 core items e.g. cereal for an extra piece of toast.

Fruit will also be available on a daily basis.

Mrs Anderson will supervise the children having breakfast. Children will be expected to remain in the dining hall until 8.40am and then, if they wish, they can join their friends in the playground.
