### Covid Procedures

When we return to school after the October break some of our Covid procedures will change. We are no longer required to have a staggered start/finish, children can now mix within the playground as bubbles are no longer required and PE can now take place indoors as well as outside.

As of Monday 18<sup>th</sup> October <u>all children</u> will begin their school day at 8.55am and finish at 3.00pm.

To help minimise congestion the children will enter/exit through the following gates:

P1, P2 and P7 through the gate at the top of the lane.

P3 and P4 through the gate at the side of the dining room.

P5 and P6 through the gate on Ladywell Road

P1 parents can still enter the playground to wait for their child.

P3 and P4 parents are still welcome to stand in the car park to wait for their child, however please do not allow children to run around the staff cars.

Again, to minimise congestion, where possible could **only one adult per family** collect children at the end of the day.

#### Covid Symptoms

Although some procedures are changing, if your child is displaying any Covid symptoms it is important that you continue to arrange a PCR test and isolate them until you have the results. We ask that you inform the school if you are doing this and also when you get the result.

### Face Coverings

Please note that face coverings should still be worn (unless exempt) when dropping off and collecting your child from school.

## <u>PE</u>

Please note that uniform for outdoor PE is black joggers, leggings or shorts with a plain white or yellow t-shirt or polo shirt. Black sweatshirts can be worn in cold weather but should not be branded with any logos.

The vast majority of children are wearing the correct uniform - thank you for that.

If you require support in providing your child with the correct outdoor uniform please contact me at the school and I will help in any way I can.
