### Covid Guidelines

As you know, the guidance around Covid is ever changing. I have detailed the current information relevant to schools below.

# Changes to Isolation Guidelines

There is no longer a requirement for a PCR test for <u>asymptomatic</u> people who test positive on a lateral flow test (asymptomatic means that they are not displaying any symptoms of Covid). They should isolate as a positive case for 10 days. However, if they test negative on a lateral flow test on Day 6 and again 24 hours later on Day 7 they may leave isolation after the Day 7 test, providing they have no symptoms.

Any person with Covid symptoms must book a PCR test and isolate until they get their result.

Children who are close contacts of positive cases should do a daily lateral flow test for 7 days.

Providing these tests are negative and they have no symptoms, they can attend school throughout this time

They only need to have a PCR test and isolate if they show symptoms.

If you are unsure at any time, whether your child should attend school, please contact the school office for advice.

Please remember, to minimise the number of adults in the building, visitors and parents will access the building **BY APPOINTMENT ONLY**.

If you require to speak to a member of staff about any concerns please contact the school office to arrange a suitable appointment. Please do not use Teams/Twitter/ SeeSaw to alert us to any concerns as these may not be checked daily.
