Covid Symptoms

Please note that uniform for outdoor PE is black joggers, leggings or shorts with a plain white or yellow t-shirt or polo shirt. Black sweatshirts can be worn in cold weather but should not be branded with any logos.

If children come to school not wearing the correct PE kit they will be given a letter to take home.
